Please attach the letter to this form. Letters of support from faculty members are helpful but are not required.

Applications should be submitted by the end of the spring semester for a scholarship to be awarded the following fall semester. Minimum grants are \$500; maximum, \$1000. The amount awarded will be determined by the amount of unmet need certified by the Office of Student Financial Affairs.
