



## UF Honors Scholars Nomination Instructions

Thank you for nominating a student for UF Honors Scholars Program. This program includes John V. Lombardi Scholars and Stamps Scholars, the top merit-based scholarships awarded to first year students at UF. Honors Program faculty will identify students as Lombardi Scholars or Stamps Scholars after selection.

Criteria for the award include the following, but it is not expected that students will excel in all areas. Students with exceptional potential in one or two areas often stand out more than those that are “well-rounded.”

- Intellectual curiosity and creativity
- Civic responsibility
- Leadership potential
- Adaptability
- Evidence of strong moral character

A high school may nominate no more than two seniors who have applied to the University of Florida and the UF Honors Program.

The [Nomination Form](#) must be completed by a school counselor or administrator. Home schooled students may be nominated by their home school advisor.

The [Recommendation Form](#) may be completed by an instructor, coach, counselor, administrator, or other person that knows the student well.

The Nomination Form, Recommendation Form, and [student application](#) must be submitted by **5pm November 14, 2021**.
